

How do students login to Freckle?

Students login to Freckle by going to <https://student.freckle.com/>.




Once there, you have a few options to have your students login to Freckle:

- If in Kindergarten or 1st grade, they will login using the K-1 login flow

K-1 Login

Students in a class with more than 50% of students rostered at a K-1 grade level will see a slightly different login flow. After entering their class code (or clicking on a recently used class code), students will see their class (first name, last initial), along with each student's avatar.




Students can click on their name to begin practice in Freckle. Note that password protection **is** an option for these classes as well. If turned on, students will enter their password after clicking on their name.

All teachers always have the option to set a password for their students to login with.

Tips for Freckle Home Use During Flex Educational Planning:


Using Freckle - Math

- Encourage students to use Freckle's student-driven adaptive practice. Students can log on to Freckle the same way they always have and **practice math on their own**. They will pick up right where they left off. To practice on their own, students just need to click the Math button on the bottom of the student dashboard and then choose a domain to work on.



Using Freckle - Reading

- Encourage students to use Freckle's ELA to learn something new this summer. Students can log on to Freckle and practice ELA on their own too! Students just need to click the ELA button at the bottom of the student dashboard. Then, they can choose to do Word Study, Skills Practice, or choose to read an article.



- Give students a set number of math assignments during this time. Both math and ELA work can be assigned from your Teacher Dashboard. For example, you can have your students complete a certain number of **adaptive practice assignments** during this time (i.e. once a week) and/or on a weekly basis. Alternatively, you can have your students practice certain math standards. Maybe you want specific students to work on certain standards. Maybe you want your 3rd graders to get exposure to some 4th grade standards. **Targeted practice assignments** allow teachers to pick specific standards for their students to work on.
- Get parents on board! Help them feel comfortable using Freckle at home by sending a quick 1-pager or email about the program. Be sure to include how students log in, including the class code. Let them know the power of using the program during this time and how it can help to continue their education. You'll want to provide expectations for parents about how often their students should be practicing.
