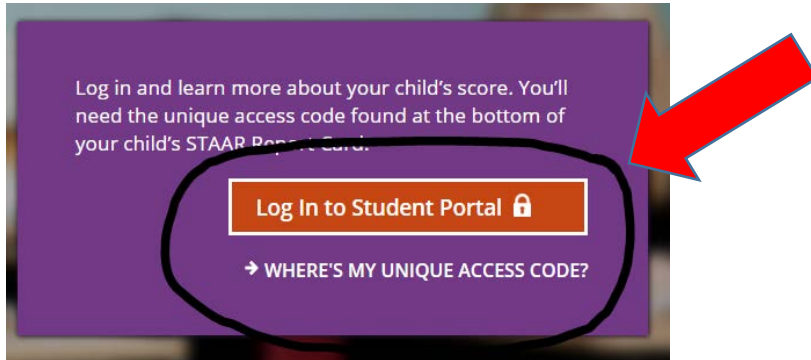


## STAAR Student Report Card

Go to [www.texasassessment.com](http://www.texasassessment.com) to access your student's testing history and information.

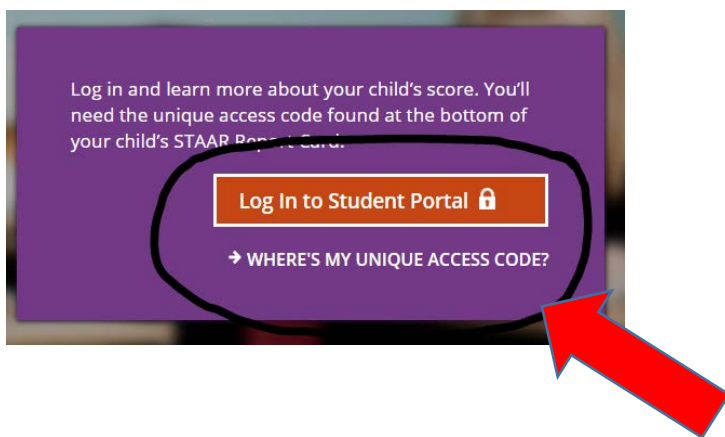
Click on the log in button located to the right of the screen.



If you have an old copy of a STAAR report card, you can locate your student's access code on the bottom left corner of the report.



If you do not have your student's access code, you can click on the link "where's my access code" to find your student's code.

To log in and view your assessment results, enter your six-character Unique Access Code and the student's date of birth that appears on your most recent STAAR Report Card. The code must be entered exactly as it appears.
